Government & Public Sector Grants

DOST-SEI RA 7687 Scholarship

Target: For talented Filipino students with high aptitude in science who belong to families with low socio-economic status.

Benefits: Tuition subsidies, monthly living allowance, book allowance, and transportation allowance.

DOST-SEI Merit Scholarship

Target: For students with high aptitude in science and mathematics, regardless of their family's socio-economic status.

Benefits: Tuition fees, monthly stipend, book allowance, and group insurance.

CHED Merit Scholarship Program (CMSP)

Target: For academically gifted students pursuing priority degree programs. Requires a high General Weighted Average (GWA).

Benefits: Full or partial financial assistance for tuition and other school fees, plus a stipend.

CHED Tulong Dunong Program

Target: Financial assistance for qualified students who need help paying for tuition and other school fees.

Benefits: Fixed financial grant per academic term.

OWWA Education for Development Scholarship Program (EDSP)

Target: For qualified dependents of active OWWA members (OFWs). Selection is based on DOST exam results.

Benefits: Financial assistance per academic year until completion of a 4-5 year baccalaureate course.

OWWA OFW Dependent Scholarship Program (ODSP)

Target: For dependents of OFWs who receive a monthly salary below a certain threshold.

Benefits: Educational assistance for any 4-year or 5-year baccalaureate course or associate degree.

GSIS Educational Subsidy Program (GRASP)

Target: For children or dependents of GSIS members with the lowest salary grades.

Benefits: Annual subsidy for tuition and other school fees.

Private Sector & Corporate Foundations

SM Foundation College Scholarship

Target: Focuses on Engineering, Computer Science, Accounting, and Education. Open to public high school graduates.

Benefits: Full tuition, monthly allowance, part-time job opportunities during breaks, and exclusive job offers upon graduation.

Ayala Foundation (Laging Handa / U-Go)

Target: Supports promising students, particularly women and those from partner communities, to complete their degrees.

Benefits: Financial stipend, mentorship, and leadership development programs.

Gokongwei Brothers Foundation (STEM)

Target: Dedicated to students pursuing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics degrees.

Benefits: Full tuition coverage, book allowance, and graduation fees.

BPI Foundation (Pagpupugay)

Target: Specifically for the children of medical front-liners and marginalized communities.

Benefits: Scholarship grant, allowance, and eventual employment opportunities within the BPI group.

Megaworld Foundation Scholarship

Target: For students pursuing degrees in architecture, engineering, interior design, and business.

Benefits: Full tuition, allowance, and guaranteed employment within Megaworld Corporation.

Cebuana Lhuillier Foundation

Target: Provides educational assistance to working students and ALS (Alternative Learning System) learners.

Benefits: Tuition assistance and academic recognition awards.

Security Bank Foundation

Target: For students in partner universities taking up business, finance, or accountancy courses.

Benefits: Tuition and miscellaneous fees coverage, plus internship opportunities.

Insular Life (Gold Eagle) Scholarship

Target: For Mathematics, Education, and Statistics majors. Prioritizes dependents of policyholders.

Benefits: Tuition fees, stipend, and book allowance.

International Opportunities

Fulbright Graduate Student Program (USA)

Target: For Filipinos who wish to pursue graduate studies (Master's or PhD) in the United States.

Benefits: Round-trip airfare, tuition, monthly stipend, health insurance, and visa support.

Australia Awards Scholarships

Target: For Filipinos to study at Australian universities. Focuses on development goals like trade, infrastructure, and peace.

Benefits: Full tuition, return air travel, establishment allowance, and health cover.

Chevening Scholarships (UK)

Target: Funded by the UK Government for one-year Master's degrees. Aimed at future leaders and influencers.

Benefits: Full university fees, monthly stipend, travel costs to and from the UK.

MEXT Scholarship (Japan)

Target: Japanese Government scholarship for research students, undergraduate students, and specialized training.

Benefits: Full tuition waiver, monthly allowance, and round-trip airfare to Japan.

New Zealand Manaaki Scholarships

Target: For postgraduate studies in New Zealand, focusing on sectors like renewable energy and disaster risk management.

Benefits: Full tuition, living allowance, establishment allowance, and medical insurance.
